



Job Title: Speech Language Pathology or Clinical Fellow

Description: HopeSparks Children's Developmental Services, Early Intervention program is seeking a full-time Speech Language Pathology or Clinical Fellow (CF) to provide quality speech-language therapy for infants and toddlers with special needs as well as training and support for their families and caregivers.

Speech-language services are provided in families' homes, therapy clinics, childcare facilities, and a variety of community settings throughout Pierce County. The SLP-CF will receive a mentored professional experience by an ASHA certified SLP who meets the mentor requirements as defined by the American Speech-Language Hearing Association.

The SLP or CF will meet regularly with parents and caregivers to provide developmentally appropriate educational and therapeutic intervention as directed by the family and child's Individualized Family Service Plan (IFSP). This person will also coordinate closely with the child's Family Resources Coordinator (FRC), CDS EI team, and any additional community medical and therapeutic professionals.

Qualifications:

- Completion of Master's level academic course work and clinical practicum from a CAA-accredited graduate program in speech-language pathology.
- Must possess a positive attitude and friendly manner with strong verbal and written communication skills
- Ability to work collaboratively with parents, caregivers, and professionals.
- Intermediate level of computer skills: application knowledge in Word, Excel, and Google Calendar, Docs, and Mail.
- First Aid and CPR certification -- able to obtain on the job
- Must have a valid Washington State driver's license, automobile for on the job use and proof of current automobile insurance
- Must pass state and national background check

Work Schedule: Position is salaried at 40 hours. A typical work day is from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm as services are provided in the child's home. Candidate must be somewhat flexible to accommodate the child and family's schedule.

Benefits: HopeSparks offers full benefits to all team members working 30 or more hours per week. Benefits include, medical, dental, vision, Life, Long Term Disability, 403b retirement. 10 paid holidays and generous PTO accrual.
