### Pediatric Healthcare Integration

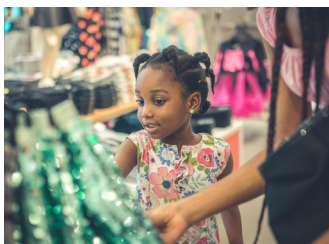
Partnering with pediatric practices to provide collaborative care for children and families. Both medical and behavioral healthcare are provided in primary care or other clinical settings.

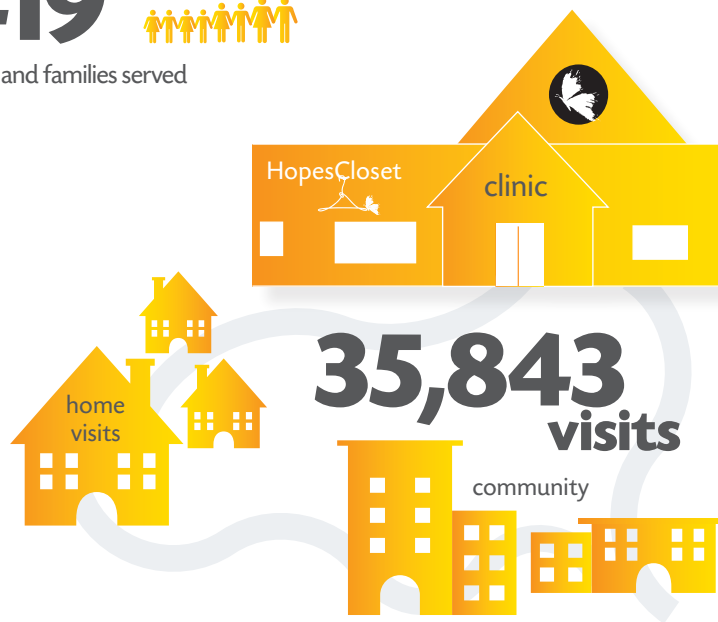
